## Introduction

**Covid!** is a race between players to win four points, or – in game terms – to **Vaccinate** all 'Concerns'.

2-4 Players, 10+.

Warning: the game includes sensitive content which younger players may find distressing. Themes of death, illness, poverty, domestic violence and mental illness.

#### You Will Need

- The 55 cards that came with your copy of Covid!
- Roughly 7 Trust tokens per player (not included loose change works well)
- A coin to decide ties



## How to Play

### Setup

**Covid!** comes with 18 green 'Vaccine' cards, 16 blue 'Concern' cards, and 21 red 'Event' cards (see *Card Anatomy*). Split these into three separate decks and shuffle each deck separately.

Deal each player 4 **Concerns** and 4 **Events**. **Concerns** are public while **Events** are secret to each player. Each player places their **Concerns** face-up on the table in portrait, and keeps their **Events** in hand.

The **Vaccine** deck and remaining **Events** are placed face-down in separate piles in the centre of the table.

Each player takes 5 **Trust** tokens from a central pool.

## First Time Walkthrough

The game is split into rounds. Each round begins by revealing the top **Vaccine** from the **Vaccine** deck.

Players then assess their base stats. Whoever is furthest from winning the **Vaccine** plays first. (In the case of a tie, whoever has more **Vaccinated Concerns** plays first. In the case of another tie, flip a coin to play first.)

For example, if the Vaccine is INTERNATIONAL AID, the player with the most Health across their Concerns plays first.

Players then take it in turns to play **Events** or **Concern Abilities** in such a way that they might win the round. A player may initiate as many **Events** or **Abilities** as they wish before passing the turn to the next player clockwise. Alternatively, a player can fold, forfeiting the round (see *Game Mechanics*).

Note: unless otherwise stated, **Events** and **Abilities** can act on players who did not initiate them. For example, ECONOMIC DOWNTURN can be used to reduce a different player's Economy.

Play continues around the circle indefinitely until all players except one have folded or been made unable to play. The remaining player wins the round. They place the **Vaccine** card beneath one of their **Concerns** – this **Concern** is now **'Vaccinated'**. If this player has now **Vaccinated** all their **Concerns**, they win the game (see *Game Mechanics* – *Winning a Round*).

Players then draw 1 **Event** card each (regardless of how many they played). When there are no **Events** remaining, all discarded **Events** are reshuffled and made into a new **Event** deck.

The **Health**, **Economy** and **Links** of all **Concerns** are reset to their base values, and a new round begins.

#### **Game Mechanics**

#### Health, Economy and Links

**Health** and **Economy** are the two stats given to every **Concern** (see *Card Anatomy – Concerns*). They are used to win **Vaccines** and can be altered by **Abilities** and **Events**. They reset to their base values at the end of every round.



**Links** are connections between **Concerns** that are formed or broken by **Abilities** and **Events**. Like **Health** and **Economy**, these are used to win **Vaccines** and reset at the end of the round. **Links** are 'two-way': if PERFORMER **Links** to INFLUENCER, then INFLUENCER is also **Linked** to PERFORMER and this only constitutes one **Link**.

Multiple **Concerns** may **Link** to one specific **Concern**. For example, if CEO is **Linked** to BIG PHARMA and CAREHOMES, then CEO is said to have 2 **Links**. However, BIG PHARMA and CAREHOMES only have 1 **Link** each and are not **Linked** to one another.

#### **Trust**

Certain **Events** or **Abilities** require a sacrifice of **Trust** to be played. These cannot be played unless the player 'spends' the appropriate number of **Trust** tokens from their personal collection into the central pool.

Other **Events** and **Abilities** enable players to gain **Trust**. When these are played, players take the appropriate number of tokens from the central pool and add them to their personal collection.

#### **Kneeling, Standing and Abilities**

Certain **Concerns** have **Abilities** which may be triggered by 'kneeling' the **Concern**. When a **Concern** is in portrait orientation it is said to be standing, and may be knelt by rotating it to landscape orientation.

Once a **Concern** is kneeling, it cannot be knelt again until it has 'stood' once more. **Concerns** cannot stand of their own volition, but certain **Events** can be played to stand them.

#### "May Play" Conditions

Certain **Vaccines** such as FOR THE FRONT LINE carry conditions like "only *Workers* may play". This means that only cards with the *Worker* trait can contribute **Health** or **Economy** to the round or trigger **Abilities**. Additionally, **Links** to non-*Worker* cards do not count. However, other cards may still be knelt or stood by **Events** such as PLANDEMIC – "Stand all **Concerns** controlled by you".


#### Winning a Round

If a player wins a round, but is unable to **Vaccinate** a **Concern**, the **Vaccine** passes to the player who came in second place and so on until someone is able to **Vaccinate** a **Concern**. If no one can **Vaccinate** a **Concern**, the **Vaccine** is discarded, and a new round begins.

For example, if the Vaccine is SUPER-COLD STORAGE and the winning player controls an already-Vaccinated BIG PHARMA (which carries the highest Economy), that player must pass the Vaccine to the player in 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
