GAME IDEA

KNOW YOUR PRIVILEDGE



THE BROAD IDEA OF THE GAME ...

is that players are randomly assigned a role. Their role card gives information about their passport, gender identity, health condition, education, profession, and age. These form their privileges and disadvantages for the game. The aim of the game is to win the race against time, the race against the destructive climate impacts.

EVERY ROUND ...

the game master reads out event, and depending on the players' preconditions, they can take a step forward. The person standing furthest upfront wins the Climate Run. Each round's event covers direct or indirect threats of the climate crisis. It encourages the players to reflect upon their role's vulnerability, resilience. and the opportunities to adapt to threats of the climate crisis.









AT THE END ...

players will stand the at different places in the room and the diverse inequalities between their roles become visible. Based on the game, the game master initiates a discussion about the different privileges and disadvantages people face. Ideally, the players learn about the manifold consequences of the climate crisis and understand that not every person can run from them. They recognize the urgency of immediate and comprehensive climate action and appreciate the need for intersectional perspectives of climate justice.

RULES

OF THE CLIMATE RUN



GAME PREPARATION

Choose a game master

- you remain a neutral player
- you read out the Action Cards

Role Cards

- randomly draw a role card
- this forms your conditions for the Climate Run

Carefully read your Role Card

- anything unclear?
 lookup anything you need to
- anything unmentioned?
 Get creative and make it up

Shhhh...

- keep your identity to yourself for the duration of the game
- you will be able to discuss the roles at the end

LET'S GET STARTED!

On your mark, get set, go!

- All players stand up
- Line up at one side of the wall, face the opposite side

Each round

- the game master draws a card and reads it out loud
- all players take a step forward ...unless, and here comes the catch: your role does not fit the described privilege

- go through the decks in the right order
- end with the reflection deck

After a long period of drought in summer, heavy rainfall and storms hit your country. People near the coast and in vulnerable housing are especially affected.

Extreme rainfall, droughts, and water shortages lead to crop failure and make food production costlier. Not everyone can afford the increased prizes.

Extreme heat, fires, and heavy rains can destroy important infrastructures such as roads, schools, and healthcare. Especially those in remote areas and need for medication are vulnerable.

CASE OF INFRASTRUCTURE

FAILURE

Sea acidification! The Ocean absorbs around 30% of emitted CO2. This slows down global warming but causes seawater to acidify. Coral reefs bleach and eventually die. One of their functions is to protect coastal areas from storms and waves.

DO NOT STEP FORWARD IF ...

Heatwave! This summer is outstandingly hot. Some pre-conditions make people more likely to suffer from extreme heat. This includes the elderly, young children, and people with health conditions like obesity, heart issues, or those taking antidepressant medication.

Heavy Bushfires! The ongoing drought has led to heavy bushfires in areas with high tree volumes. Especially populations working outside or with health conditions such as asthma are vulnerable to fires.

DO NOT STEP FORWARD IF ...

YOU ARE LIKELY TO SUFFER FROM HEAVY BUSHFIRES IN YOUR REGION

Water shortage! Rainfall outages, salination of groundwater, and drying up mountain springs can cause dangerous water shortages. Particularly farmers and poor populations are vulnerable.
