





- Charity logistics is complex involving paid & volunteer staff
- Shops have their own targets but are being encouraged to collaborate
- Donations can be over door, donation banks, house clearances, commercial
- Greater visibility needed of transport and flexibility in servicing
- What if a business social network could see its patterns & transactions across space & time?
- Would managers tap into this network to share stock/transport and realise network opportunities?
- A tool to enable experimentation with space-time relationships, social networks and business collaboration










- 407 messages exchanged over 93 days
- 25% of messages sent after 17:00 and 19% after 19:00
- 4/6 managers happy to message out-of-hours (younger smartphone enabled managers more inclined). Personal friendships important factor
- More enquiries in PM, stock management AM
- Planning and/or decision making better informed 85%
- All but 1 manager agreed that their understanding of how time was used in the business had improved
- 67% managers agreed they had collaborated more
- App can just pass on scheduling problems to other people unless the rules governing its use are not tightly controlled






