

Participants Needed for Study on Experience of Living with Bowel Incontinence

Your perspective matters! This research study seeks to explore what it is like to live with bowel incontinence and how this impacts people's decisions related to seeking medical care and following treatment recommendations. You will be asked to participate in one interview, in-person or via video call, with the possibility of a brief follow-up interview, which can be conducted over the phone. - You are over the age of 18
- You have fecal incontinence defined as the inability to defer defecation for more than five minutes
- You are a resident of the United Kingdom
- You can read, write, speak, and understand English
