Guidance

Quickly observe the exhibition and artworks—what colours? What mood? What theme?

Attempt to answer the following questions:

Can I understand this exhibition?

Which piece made the strongest impression on me? Why?

Do I feel included or excluded?

Which scene from real life does this exhibition remind me of?...
