

Inverleith Park and Pond Stroll: Highlights

The 1-mile long stroll starts at the far side of rugby pitch (centre of photo), proceeds along the tree-fringed lane (left-centre) between cricket and rugby grounds, skirts the pond, ascends the gently curving tree-lined avenue (front of photo), stops to admire the panoramic view (skyline in photo), heads towards old farm house (extreme lefthand edge of photo), descends through the sundial garden (grass near lefthand edge of photo) and returns to the starting point.
