During lockdown, in London, there was a massive increase in people whose mental health had deteriorated due to the stress and anxiety of not just out of fear of this unknown virus, to which there is still no cure, but also out of fear for their jobs. Many people lost their jobs and businesses, due to them being liquidated to pay off the debts owed. 


<u>MAKING AND</u> BREAKING NARRATIVE

Even now, with all the restrictions, some of still feel the same because even though we




Making my friends jealous because I'm eating Byron and they had to make food. (Houseparty)

My friends and I debating whether it is ok to eat pig/pork as we are Christians. (Discord)




Wishing happy birthday to my friend, and her opening a gift I got her because I was unable to be there to see her open it. (Houseparty)
