The lecture will include references to the building of Persepolis and its modern restoration, as well as examples of the conservation and restoration of Iranian historic cities and the development challenges at the present.

Mehr Azar Soheil has an M.Sc. in Architecture from Tehran University. She received specialised training in conservation at ICCROM and the Scuola di Perfezionamento di Restauro at the Sapienza University of Rome, where she obtained her PhD. Her doctoral thesis discusses the significance of monument in the Achaemenid Empire. She is the acting secretary general for ICOMOS Training Committee, member of the Theory and Philosophy Committee, and the Scientific Committee of ARCo Association in Italy. Her publications include articles on conservation. She has participated in international conferences and lectured in conservation training programmes.
