David Page is Director of Architecture in Page /Park Architects and Visiting Professor at Strathclyde University. Key projects related to important historical contexts include Eden Court Theatre Inverness, McManus Art Gallery and Museum in Dundee, National Portrait Gallery and Fettes College's Spence Building in Edinburgh, Roslyn Chapel south of Edinburgh, St Columbkille's Roman Catholic Church in Rutherglen, the Lighthouse Centre for Architecture and Design, Kelvin Hall refurbishment and the extension to the Theatre Royal for Scottish Opera in Glasgow.

The masterclass will focus on the conservation approach of Page/Park Architects and the many challenges of the project following the major fire in May 2014 at Charles Rennie Mackintosh Glasgow School of Art.
