The workshops will be small , around 6-8 people

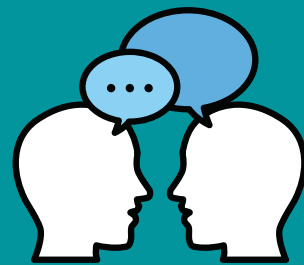
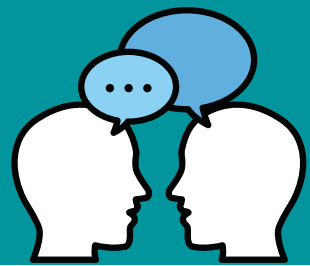
They will take place either online or face to face
